On the first Sunday there were 38 in attendance. The sermon was entitled, "What makes a Great Church?, The people learned that church is not great because it has an expensive piece of property, but rather is great because it is a local assembly of baptized believers possessing some tremendous Biblical traits. They discovered that the local church at Jerusalem didn't even have a building. However, the believers had, 1. Great Power(Acts 4:33a), 2. Great Grace(Acts 4:33b), 3. Great Fear(Acts 5:11), 4. Great Persecution(Acts 8:8), 5. Great Forgiveness(Acts 7:60), 6. Great Harvest(Acts 14:1) and 7. Great Joy
