REPORT OF KARIN'S HEALTH

Since Karin's surgery in July 2015, the Drs felt best for her to recuperate until starting her Chemotherapy treatments in Oct 2015. The cancer did not spread as results from the removal of lymph nodes. She was considered High Risk with results from a genetic testing. She had to have 6 Chemo treatments, 3 wks apart. She was suppose to receive a shot of Neulasta to bring her white blood count up. Well, she did not receive her first shot because there was a problem with the health insurance. She was admitted in the hospital with her white blood count very low of 0.6(normal is 4.6). In the hospital she led 3 people to the Lord. The Lord always protects us. It was a very difficult time for her but the Lord sustained her every minute of the day.

My report from the Dr has been very good. My blood pressure is improving and everything else is ok too. I still walk with my cane and the Dr will give me the OK real soon to start driving. This will be an answer to our prayers.
