Dear Praying Friends,

Lost. I think the saddest verse in the Bible is Jeremiah 8:6 *"The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved."* Our duty is to take the good news of the Gospel to the lost so that they can trust Christ as their Savior. I had the privilege of winning a 28 year old man to Christ while out knocking on doors. My son Michael, youth director of the New Horizons Baptist Church, in Fort Worth (a Hispanic church), also won someone to the Lord. Bro. Jerome, member of the same church was with us, and he had not been able to win anyone to Christ that day. As we were going back to the car, we saw a man outside of his home. Jerome asked if we had witnessed to him. I told him that when we went to that house no one opened the door. So off he went, desirous of winning someone himself!

Our burden is to see the lost saved. In our churches in Mexico, the only place we have where we can talk to people is the street corner! Most of the new works are meeting in rented or borrowed homes. Bethesda is having two services on Sunday mornings and children's church at night to accommodate the growing attendance. Please be in prayer about supporting the Monterrey Building Fund, so that churches can borrow from this fund interest free, buy or build, and then pay it back so that other works can use the same funds.



Sharing this burden on furlough has been blessed of God. Two new churches have committed to start supporting us. Two supporting churches have taken on the Institute (more of this in the next institute letter). Two have taken on the Monterrey Building Fund for support. We hope many more will join in the effort of evangelizing not only Mexico, but also the world through those that we are training. Note: Seven people were saved during the special Christmas program at Bethesda!

Traveling on furlough we have also seen God's hand. Our travels in December have taken us to Texas and Florida. In January we will be in Florida, Georgia, Alabama, Louisiana and Texas! Please keep us in your prayers as we travel and as we share. Pray that God will use us to bring honor to His name.
