I want to present to you the plans for the land that God has allowed us to purchase for our church planting endeavors. The land is located on the outskirts of town with just under four minutes from major housing and businesses.

Our goal is three phases but for now, we are focusing on the first phase that consist with closing the property with a nine-foot wall all around (21 yards in width x 32 yards in length). In addition, to build the first meeting place which will start out as a basement (later to build two floors on top for the future). Along, with a two separate (outhouses) restrooms made of cement apart from the main building. The first phase project will estimate to \$20,000.00 dollars. Any portion amount given for this church planting work will be a blessing.
