We are ever grateful for your prayers. We can't see into tomorrow and thus don't always know what our prayer needs are. Thank you for your faithful prayers that once again brought us through difficult times.

February 15th I fell very ill and on the 16th was admitted to the hospital with a blocked intestine. The doctors decided that an emergency operation had to be performed after many efforts to unblock it, gangrene would set in. Saturday night at 9 pm I was wheeled into the operating room. I spent ten days in the hospital and am told it will be a couple of months to fully recover. I am doing well.

Praying is so important. Many missionaries are leaving the mission field. It has been sad to lose some of the old timers as they go to be with the Lord. It is even sadder as some have had to leave Honduras because of the high crime and threats. Two missionaries in Siguatepeque have been shot and another threatened and they have left. Another great sadness is to see others leave because of losing support. With cost of living having doubled recently and support being cut because of the economy in the US many could not stay. The need for missionaries is greater than ever. Siguatepeque has grown since I have been in Honduras from a small village to almost 90,000 people I was told yesterday. We must seek the Lord for His intervention, souls are yet to be reached and time is short.

Recently two adults have been saved as we have prayed. It is good to see others growing strong in the Lord. The works continue to grow. I enjoyed preaching in the mission last Sunday. We pray that the Lord will allow another mission to be started, that He would give us men willing to preach and teachers to teach the Bible and one day have another organized church.
