
Dear Pastor and Church:

We so much appreciate your prayers for us and for the country of Honduras. Please pray for this country as crime and violence are increasing dramatically, even in our formerly peaceful town. Murders and kidnappings were never heard of before, but now they happen regularly. Robberies have always been a problem. The use and the trafficking of drugs have created a new mafia in Honduras and it has long reaching tentacles. The loss of the majority of the crops due to the unusually heavy rains in August, September, and October has added pressure to the situation. More people are willing to steal due to unemployment. The economic situation here is very difficult. It seems like a pressure cooker about to explode. **Truly Christ is the only HOPE. Please pray for our protection.**

In our last letter, we mentioned Vacation Bible School was to be in September during the Independence Day holiday. Due to a teachers strike, this holiday was cancelled. So we postponed the VBS until January. We are excited about a recently saved couple who is planning their **wedding** for December. They have already started the legal process in city hall. Their oldest son that just turned 16 has been praying for their salvations for several years. They want to have a church wedding as well. The father of two of our families passed away in October. He died from alcoholism and as far as everyone knows, **without Christ**. It was very difficult to preach at this wake and burial.

Your **prayers are definitely coveted** as we continue to serve the Lord here, winning souls, baptizing and discipling new believers, and establishing churches. Please pray also for our financial support. We understand the difficult situation many of our supporting churches and your families are facing in the U.S. and we **pray for you** also. **Thank you** for your prayers and financial support. May God bless you greatly.
