In September, we celebrated the country's annual Children's Day. God blessed us with an overflowing crowd of 120 children and at least 40 adults that brought them. We emphasized the Gospel story of the Wordless Book. The children were divided into three classes taught by Alba and two other ladies. All of the adults also heard the Gospel and received a tract. Also in September, a young couple had their civil wedding. Here only the city hall and lawyers have the authorization to marry people. They asked me to be one of the witnesses. They are planning a church ceremony for December. The new bride will be baptized soon.

October 5th and 6th we held our annual Men's Conference. We had men from three churches. This year instead of my Dad teaching everything, a Honduran Pastor taught one class and I taught a class. We had a great time of fellowship and learning. Please pray for the men in the different missions and churches here.



Once a week I teach a class on Values at a night school for teens and adults who have not finished grade school. This week I teach the last class of this school year. I praise the Lord for the liberty to use the Bible to teach these values and to be able to share the Gospel with them. Please pray for these students as they come from difficult situations and they need the Lord.

Thank you so much for your prayers and financial support. We count it a privilege to be your missionaries in Honduras. We pray each of you will have a wonderful Thanksgiving. Please pray for one of my uncles, Leroy Duncan, who is suffering from cancer. But, we are praying for a miracle. May the Lord bless you.
