I moved down on the 28th of May and took almost



everything with me. It was a rough couple of first weeks, but I am slowly becoming accustomed to the life here. I work 3 days in our clinic, which allows me to meet a lot of people of different backgrounds and through that be able to witness to them, even if just for a brief moment. The rest of my week I spend in a larger village working with a church called *Iglesia Bautista "La Gran Comision."* There, I teach every Thursday evening. I am also starting to work with the teenagers and have begun Sunday School classes with them. We have also been doing many visits with members and non-members. It is amazing to see the ministry on this side. I have had the opportunity to hear the stories of many people and their

deep desire to come out of sin. Unfortunately, most of the people here believe in a works-based salvation and acceptance. Now that I have been here and worked more in depth, I have realized the incredible confusion that different cults and denominations have brought to the people. It is certainly a difficult people to reach, but the Lord gives much grace. I'm working with a 25 year old who wants to change in order to save his marriage. Please pray for

him, his name is Agustin. I am praying for the Holy Spirit to do a work in his heart to see him get saved. He was an outcome of the Family Conference which we had in June. Satan tried to hinder us, but the Lord had other plans and we saw God do great things with the families. We were also able to make some connections with a few visitors.

I would also like to thank everyone who donated towards me getting vehicle here in Mexico! I now have the car and it has been a tremendous help. It saves a lot on gas, which is almost 6 dollars a gallon here. It is already a Mexican vehicle, so there is no need to take out any special paperwork on it.



I have also begun working on my Mexican citizenship. Please pray that the process will go smoothly, and Lord willing, that I can have it all done before getting married. I am excited to see what the Lord has for the future!
