## A GIFT THAT KEEPS ON GIVING

Goliath stood for forty days in the valley of Elah and defied the armies of Israel and the God of Israel. When young David confronted Goliath, he made the amazing proclamation of the purpose of his coming victory over this Giant. "That all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel." David is a central figure in God's great plan of redemption of the lost human race. In Acts 13:22, God tells us why he chose David and tells of the eternal culmination of his royal lineage when he states; "I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfill all my will." Then Luke adds under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, "Of this man's seed hath God according to his promise raised unto Israel a Saviour, Jesus."

God chose to begin this story in 1 Samuel with a barren and troubled young wife named Hannah. For a long time, she suffered the many failings of her culture. There was immorality both in the priesthood and in her household, and while she found no consolation there, she still had hope. Her great desire was for a son, and she knew where to turn as she came to offer her prayers to the God of Israel. She acted in faith on the truth stated in James 1:17, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."

God answered Hannah's prayers and gave her a son. She called his name Samuel, saying, "Because I have asked him of the LORD." When Samuel was weaned, Hannah did an uncommon thing. She brought her son Samuel back to the House of God at Shiloh and left him there that he might serve the Lord for as long as he lived. When Samuel was old, having served God since childhood; he anointed David to be the King of Israel.

God begins the great story of King David by telling us of Hannah who gave back to God the precious gift that God had given to her in answer to her prayers. Has God given you the desire of your heart, - the answer to your prayers? God has been known to change the world when such a gift is given back to Him for His glory.
