On the Wings of Prayer

"Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the Shadow of thy wings will I rejoice:" Psalm 63:7

Acts 3 and 4 tells a remarkable story of Peter, John and the healing of a lame beggar who was daily brought to the Temple. While the people that witnessed this miracle were filled with wonder and amazement, the leaders of the Temple were grieved when they heard the disciples teaching them faith in Jesus Christ. After Peter and John were arrested and brought to the High Priest and his court, the story arrives at the great conclusion of all those at the hearing. This conclusion I have chosen as my title. "They had been with Jesus". This is the only explanation for the notable miracle that took place.

It all started almost 4 years earlier. As they were in the midst of a day's work as fishermen, Jesus walked by. When he called "Follow Me", they immediately left all and followed Jesus. Later when he chose them to be his disciples and prepare them for ministry, they continued daily with Him in his busy schedule, "and when they were alone, he expounded all things to his disciples" (Mark 4:34). Without the commitment to be with Jesus, they could not be Christ's disciple. Do you daily spend time alone with Jesus? It is a special time for Jesus and it should be for us also.

When they faltered under trials, Jesus had already prayed for them, then sought them and brought them back to him (Luke 22:32; Mark 16:7). He also cares for you and will never leave you or forsake you!

When He empowered them, they turned the world upside down with the Gospel of Christ. I fear that our greatest temptation that will lead us to failure is to attempt to do the work of God in our own power. Peter's testimony to the lame man before he was healed was this "Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee".

Will it be said of us by those who examine our ministry "They have been with Jesus"?
