Dear Faithful Friends

This may be hard to believe, but we are having a good time on the Warm Springs Indian Reservation. It has truly been a wonderful month in March and also in April. We had some good meetings that just seem to get better, and it takes us into the next meeting in a way that keeps everything moving forward.

March...was a good month for those on school break and wanting to do work in the Reservation community. The first week was a college group from Boston of about eighteen students; who contributed by helping do clean-up, doing a lot of work for people and for social services, and witnessing along the way.

They were followed by middle school students of about fifty-two from Oregon City. They helped tremendously with our building needs, painting, landscaping, and moving old things to the dump. They did a great job and knew how to work! Also, they helped with our music on the Lord's Day. One of the teens got saved...Praise the Lord!

The next group was our Native American Baptist Fellowship. Our church really got a blessing from them. We had good attendance with a full house and saw two salvations, twelve rededications, and three families joined the church! The NABF preachers always come through with a good spirit and great preaching to help the local church.

April...started out with an early morning sunrise service on the mountain. There were about thirty in attendance. They came to sing and give testimony of how the Resurrection of our Lord has been the difference maker for them. Next, we followed with breakfast prepared by the men of the church, and then a great message on the resurrection. The Lord moved on some hearts to make decisions with eternity

The next week, we had a man about forty give his testimony. He surprised us by telling us that the Lord was leading him into ministry. He is not sure of the what and where yet. Please pray for Rusty.

Then, there's revival... the moving of the Lord on the people of God! The Lord used our Evangelist Gary Locklear, and he really made Jesus our Blessed Redeemer. The people responded with their hearts and not just with their mouths....Amen!

Gary and I made a trip to the Nooksack Reservation (NW Washington) a week before the Revival and held a two night meeting. The first night we had twenty-six. The next night, we had thirty-nine. We were praying to get something going there, and now, we are seeing that take place. I have an older man and his wife from the Tacoma Indian Baptist Church who will carry that work until we can get someone there...pray for Bill and Lena. So keep praying for the results that the Lord can bring, as we are faithful to His Work!

June...we have had good altar response and some saved, but the visitors coming is a good indication people are hungry for the Truth of God's Word. Regina and I helped with summer camp. We had a good time!

July...we are planning a three day VBS for K-5th graders. Also, a VBS for middle schoolers is coming in August.

Prayer Needs: The bus ministry, summer activities, VBS and children's salvation, Good News Club in the public school, a couple coming up from Texas, and my wife who is retiring from social work employment.



## J. FRANK NORRIS-A MAN AMONG MEN

## A MEMORIAL TO DR. J. FRANK NORRIS

(Continued from last issue)

PLACE OF BIRTH: DADEVILLE, ALABAMA PARENTS: WARREN AND MARY NORRIS

COLLEGE: BAYLOR UNIVERSITY (1899-1903) MARRIED: LILLIAN GADDY (1902) CHILDREN: J. FRANK, JR., JIM GADDY, LILLIAN, GEORGE GRADUATED: SOUTHERN BAPTIST SEMINARY (1905) TITLES: CRUSADER, EDITOR, PASTOR, PREACHER, STATESMAN, JOURNALIST, EDUCATOR, TRAVELER

The internationally known, colorful, controversial J. Frank Norris, a man who made things happen, changed the complexion of religious life in America.

During his pastorate of First Baptist Church, Fort Worth, Texas (1909-1952), the membership grew from nine hundred to over twelve thousand as early as 1932, with an average Sunday school attendance of 5,200.

## GOD'S BLESSING IN REVIEW

Few men carved a place in the religious world as did J. Frank Norris. The following will give the reader an idea of God's hand upon his life.

- Two years (1908-1909) editor of the Baptist Standard, the official voice of Texas
- Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas.
- Founder of the World Baptist Fellowship, an international organization of independent Baptists.
- Pastor of First Baptist Church, Fort Worth (1909-1952).
- Editor of The Fence Rail (1917-1921).
- Editor of The Searchlight (1921-1927).
- Editor of The Fundamentalist (1927-1952).
- · Described by the New York newspaper, The World Week, as "the strongest, shrewdest, most romantically adventuresome prince of crowd gatherers..."
- Conducted revival in First Baptist Church, San Antonio, Texas, where over six hundred people were saved. The meeting was described by the pastor, I. E. Yates, our PRAYERS and SUPPORT. as "a meeting that produced more results than any I've ever seen."
- Conducted a revival in First Baptist Church, Houston, Texas, in which a thousand souls were saved.
- Described by Pastor George Ragland of the First Baptist Church, Lexington, Kentucky, as "one of the greatest preachers in America."

- Spoke to legislators in Texas, Georgia, nd other states.
- Conducted one hundred twenty tent
- Spoke to large crowds in Berlin, Germany, in 1937.
- as a sovereign state. The United Nations declared Israel a state in 1948.
- Preached to twenty-five thousand people in a baseball park in Fort Worth in 1942. the same without YOU!
- Conferred with Winston Churchill, Prime Minister of Great Britain, in 1946.

#### CONCLUDING WORD

The Baptist world, groups of every stripe, are indebted to the man whose favorite verse of Scripture, inscribed on the monument at his gravesite, was Philippians 1:21: For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.

One of Dr. Norris' famous sayings was: "I would do anything to keep a man out of

His son, Dr. George Norris, said, "Whatever was said about my dad, he had a passion

I am grateful for personal memories of Dr. Norris, going back to my childhood, when my dad, Dr. R. J. Barber, Sr., engaged him a number of times to preach Bible conferences in The Baptist Tabernacle, Danville, Virginia. Would to God we could revisit those days!


