

# **INFORMED ANSWERS TO IMPORTANT QUESTIONS**

Psalm 24, one of sixteen Messianic Psalms, lends itself to the asking of important questions, while at the same time providing informed answers. The psalmist paints a word picture of the **Chief Shepherd**. The key word is "crown," and a New Testament

reference is I Peter 5:4:" And when the chief shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away."

# **QUESTION NUMBER ONE: "WHO OWNS THE WORLD?"** The answer is found in verses 1.2:

"The earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein. For he hath founded it upon the seas, and *established it upon the floods.*"

God's ownership is by virtue of creation. He is the architect, the designer, and the creator (Genesis 1:1). Don't ask God for His I.D. or His credentials. Don't ask Him to repeat Himself or present His passport or password. They are written everywhere (Psalm 19:1,2). It has been observed that the heavenly bodies are God's windsocks to remind us that the King is in residence. I should remind you that God has not abdicated His throne (Psalm 93:1), nor has He relinquished His ownership of all that is in this world (Haggai 2:8).

# QUESTION NUMBER TWO: "WHO WILL RECEIVE GOD'S BLESSING?"

The question is answered in verses 3-5:

"He that hath clean hands": clean hands symbolize a clean body, and the Christian's body is the temple of the Holy Spirit (I Corinthians 6:19,20).

"And a pure heart": Jesus said, "Blessed are the pure in heart..." (Matthew 5:2).

"Who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity" suggests a humble spirit. James says, "God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace to the humble" (James 4:6).

"Nor sworn deceitfully" This is the description of a truthful soul. "The lips of truth are established forever..." (Proverbs 12:19).

Truth crushed to the earth shall rise again, *The eternal years of God are hers:* But error, wounded, writhing in pain, Dies among her worshippers. (copied)

# **OUESTION NUMBER THREE:** "WHO WILL RULE THE WORLD?"

The answer to this question is found in verses 7-10, which clearly declare that "the King of glory" will make His grand entry into Jerusalem to establish His kingdom of righteousness and peace.

The communists will not rule the world, nor will the terrorists, nor will the atheists, nor the humanists. Iesus Christ will rule the world from His royal throne in the Holy City.

Proof? –Revelation 11:15: "The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and his Christ, and he shall reign for ever and ever." Whose world is it anyhow? Go back to Psalm 24:1: "The earth is the Lord's..."

The prayer that our Lord Jesus taught us to pray ends with these three words: "THY KINGDOM COME."

This prayer will be answered. His kingdom will come. "Out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, King of Kings and Lord of Lords" (Revelation 19:15,16).

Until Jesus occupies the throne in Jerusalem, your heart can be His throne. Crown Him today without further delay!


