Dear Pastor and Fellowlaborers,

Looking back on last year, we were blessed to travel 25,000 miles to 10 states and made many new friends while sharing our burden for Norway. We saw four salvations and five surrender to missions, including one to Norway, as well as many hearts stirred for the cause of missions. We praise the LORD for what He did in 2024.

We were so blessed to spend the Holiday Season with Jared's family. We had few meetings in November and December, including Seagoville Road Baptist Church, Lighthouse Baptist Church in Grand Prairie, and the chance to preach at Rose Avenue Baptist Church in Breckenridge, TX. We have also used this down time to refresh and reorganize for the new year's travel.

In December our car started to have some issues. It was stalling as though losing fuel. We fixed several things on it to try and alleviate it, but it eventually it died. We found a new vehicle at a good price, but had to borrow from our church and from a friend to purchase it. We will be paying that back over the course of 2025, and any assistance with this would be greatly appreciated.

In January after getting a new vehicle we have set it up for travel and gotten back to being on the road more. We were at New Life Baptist Church in Highland Village, Macedonia Baptist Church in Mesquite, Friendship Baptist Church in Mesquite, Emmanuel Baptist Church in Jacksonville, Calvary Baptist Church in Mesquite, and Victory Baptist Church in Whitehouse. News from Caxias do Sul,
Southern Brazil

February 21, 2025

Hello, friends!

What a blessed adventure this furlough has been. This is the first furlough since 2001 that we are able to travel full time together. We are now past the half way point in our travels. We will be returning to Brazil in August. We praise the Lord for His protection on the road as we've traveled around 20,000 miles in six months.

The beginning of 2025 was filled with mixed emotions. Neila's mom, Elaine Hawkins, was promoted to glory on January second. All her children and some grandchildren were by her side in her last hours, with most all surrounding her bed as she "fell asleep". We all rejoice for the missions legacy she and her husband Joe have left to the glory of God!

To date we have reported to thirty-three churches, located in Texas, the midwest, the northeast, and the east coast. We are now beginning our meetings in Arizona, California, and the Pacific Northwest.

THE DEITY OF CHRIST CONFIRMED

(Excerpt from the book by Raymond W. Barber: *What the Bible Teaches*)

I Timothy 3:16

The deity of Christ is confirmed in seven basic ways. First, **His deity is confirmed by the names given Him.** He is called “God” in Hebrews 1:8. He is called the “Son of the living God” in Matthew 16:16. He is called the “Lord” in Acts 16:31.

Second, **His deity is confirmed by the worship that is ascribed to Him.** Men and angels worship Him. Let me read it to you from the Revelation, chapter 5, verses 11 and 12:

“And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;

Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.”

And I read in Philippians chapter 2:

“Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God;

But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.”

Men everywhere one day shall worship Him when the angels fall down before Him ascribing to Him all majesty and glory and might and power and wisdom from every tribe on this terrestrial globe. Out of every kindred on the earth shall men come to pay honor to Him. Bless His wonderful name! Love Him? Yes! Adore Him? Yes! Worship Him? Yes! Crown Him Lord of all? Yes! Bring forth the royal diadem, and crown Him Lord of all!

The third fact that confirms His deity is His equality with the Father. In John, chapter 5, He is seen as being equal with the Father in working, in wisdom, in His power to resurrect the dead, in His authority to judge, in His position of honor, and in His ability to give life. He is equal with the Father.

The fourth great fact that confirms His deity is His virgin birth. In Genesis 3:15 it is prophesied that the Seed of the woman would bruise the head of Satan, the serpent. The old rabbi used to wonder about that verse. The Seed of the woman? Unheard of! The seed comes from the man. But the 750 years before Christ was born, Isaiah took the prophetic pen in hand and wrote, “The Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel,” which means “God with us.” In Luke 1:35 when the angel made the announcement to Mary, he said,

“And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.”

The virgin birth is the most important doctrine that supports the deity of the Lord Jesus Christ. The deity of Christ is the doctrine upon which all other doctrines fall or stand.

If Jesus Christ be born not of a virgin, there is no Trinity; for He is the second Person of the Trinity. If Jesus Christ be not born of a virgin, there is no resurrection; for He is the resurrection. If Jesus Christ be not born of a virgin, Christianity is only a myth that will in the end succumb to its own deception and be buried beneath the ashes of its own presumption.

Jesus Christ was virgin born. It matters not what all the infidels and agnostics and unbelievers and college professors and “baboon chasers” and D.D.’s and Ph.D.’s and everybody else says, I believe He was born of a virgin because the Bible says so. I believe He was born of a virgin because He lives in my heart. I believe! I believe! I believe that Christ is the virgin-born, sinless, perfect Son of the living God.

The fifth fact that confirms His deity is His sacrificial death upon the cross. I read in I Corinthians, chapter 15 and verse 3: “Christ died for our sins.” If He were not the divine Son of God, His death would be meaningless. His death would mean no more than your death. He must be, and He is, the Son of God because He died a sacrificial death upon the cross, Peter said in his first epistle, chapter 2, “Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.”

The sixth outstanding fact that confirms His deity is His glorious resurrection from among the dead. I read in Romans 1:4 that He is declared the Son of God by the resurrection from the dead. Before Christ there was no resurrection. Until Christ comes again, there shall not be any resurrection; for He is the resurrection and the life.

The seventh fact that confirms His deity is His triumphant return. Sweeter words were never spoken than these from John’s Gospel, chapter 14 (Vss. 1-3):

Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

In my Father’s house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself: that where I am, there ye may be also.

The deity of the Lord Jesus is the central thought and the central fiber and the central doctrine of the Bible.

Our Graduates!

Felicia Dale Blackburn is a member of Worth Baptist Church. She initially enrolled in NBBS to not only get a better grasp of the Scriptures in general, but she came to also further equip herself to teach children the truths of the Bible, something in which she was already involved at her church. While studying at NBBS, she continued to be faithful in her church and thereby growing under the combined teaching and preaching ministry of both institutions, she came to be further burdened for missions. This is an area of ministry she hopes to be more led into in the near future. She is graduating with a **One-Year Bible Diploma.** This diploma is a 36 credit hour course of study made up of 12 different Bible and doctrinal courses, as well as some practical courses. When asked what NBBS means to her, she wrote: *“My school has served as a tremendous instrument in ways I was not planning. God has used the instructors, staff, and my classmates in a beautiful way in my life. Learning and growing with these people, that I now call my NBBS family, has been a wonderful opportunity and a privilege. Without NBBS I would not have known the calling of my heart, which is missions.”*



Ryan B. Blair is the son of Pastor Roy Blair of the First Baptist Church of Meadowview, Mesquite, Texas. He is married to Rachel, and he is graduating from NBBS with an **Associate’s Degree.**

This degree is a 72 credit hour course of study in 24 Bible, doctrine, and church ministry classes. Ryan is 30 years of age, and he ultimately plans to pastor. Having been exposed as a preacher’s son to different potential sources for ministerial training, when asked what NBBS means to him, he wrote that he feels it excels in the training of preachers in keeping with his other educational involvements. A few of his comments were as such: *“NBBS has created an environment that allows one to study his Bible in an academic setting, but also pushes one to have an actual walk with Christ. My life was not on hold as I studied, and my time at Norris amplified my personal walk and my ministry at FBC of Meadowview.”*

Ray E. Caudle III is married to Rachel Caudle, and is the youth director at the Countryside Baptist Church, Mansfield, Texas. It is the church he grew up in, and the one in which he was called to preach, under the ministry of Pastor Claude Sutton, who is also longstanding instructor at NBBS. **Rachel, his wife, in the recent past earned a one-year Bible Diploma from NBBS.** They have three children. He has been an auto technician (mechanic) for nine years, and was able to take four courses a week because of the NBBS double-lecture on the same day course strategy. Hence it took him longer than four years to earn his degree, but he was active in ministry throughout his schooling. Ray is 28 years of age and is graduating with a **Bachelor’s Degree with a Bible Major and a Pastoral Minor.** This degree is a 144 credit hour course of study in 48 classes. Ray, among many positive things he had to say about NBBS, was how being taught in depth on each book of the Bible was so helpful and that the faculty is so committed to preparing the students for the ministry. He also wrote these words: *“This school, with the working of the Holy Spirit, has grounded me in the faith and helped me to grow far beyond what I ever thought possible.”*

Elisabeth Roberta Day is the wife of Isaac Day (a May 2024, NBBS graduate). They met at NBBS, and were married this past year. She assists her husband in youth ministry at Santa Fe Baptist Church, Weatherford, Texas, where he is the youth director. Elisabeth was a very good student and a joy to have in school. She was a ready help in straightening up the chapel area and classrooms after their use for the day, as well as a help in other ways to the administration. She has earned from NBBS an **Associate’s Degree.** This degree is a 72 credit hour, 24 course study in Bible, doctrine, and church ministry classes. She is planning on returning to NBBS in the future to pursue a Bachelor’s degree.



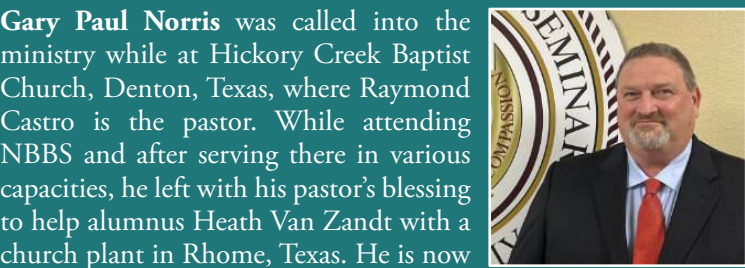
Brian K. Dull was called to the ministry while a member at Hickory Creek Baptist Church, Denton, Texas, where Raymond Castro is the pastor. He has served as the youth director and in various other areas of ministry in his church. He is a carpenter, who has had his own subcontracting remodeling business for

several years. Consequently, he has not only been a help along these lines at his church, but also at NBBS when we were in our previous facility. Brian had attended two other schools to prepare for the ministry, but when he learned of NBBS, he came our way and found it to especially be what he was looking for to prepare him for the ministry.

Brian and his wife Denise have been out in the forefront in the seminary’s involvement at the Creation Evidence Museum of Glen Rose, Texas. On one excavation along the Paluxy River – which the NBBS student body carried out under the auspices of the museum a couple of years ago – Brian, his wife, and Isaac Day uncovered tracks that have been determined to be those of a creature in the pterosaur classification of flying reptiles of the past. The size of the tracks indicate a creature with a thirty foot or more wingspan. A several foot long imprint of the trail now hangs on a wall in the aforementioned museum.

Brian is 56 years of age and is graduating with a **Bachelor’s Degree with a Bible Major and a Pastoral Minor.** This degree is a 144 credit hour course of study in 48 classes. He came with what could be described as a good running start in having his footing secure in the basics of the Bible. I remember well his early sharpness that was readily evident in class discussions in his first year in classes. Knowing that he was only recently saved at that time, it evidenced a young man whose heart the Lord had been stirring. At the church in Boyd he soon had the ministry of teaching in and overseeing the children’s ministry. He has continued to grow in his walk and is now 24 years of age and is graduating with a **Bachelor’s Degree with a Bible Major and a Pastoral Minor.** This degree is a 144 credit hour course of study in 48 classes. Damian plans to be a pastor. A statement from his personal words about NBBS included the following: *“Since coming to this school I have learned in-depth about every subject of the Bible. I have greatly grown in my grasp of the truths of God’s Word from the teaching of all the preachers and their wives.”*



Gary Paul Norris was called into the ministry while at Hickory Creek Baptist Church, Denton, Texas, where Raymond Castro is the pastor. While attending NBBS and after serving there in various capacities, he left with his pastor’s blessing to help alumnus Heath Van Zandt with a church plant in Rhome, Texas. He is now the Associate Pastor. The church has been established and is housed in a very nice facility that is their own. Prior to all of this, Gary was in the U.S. Navy from 1989-1999, where he ultimately served as a Hospitalman 2nd Class Petty Officer. Afterwards he acquired a Bachelor’s of Business Administration and an MBA with Health Service Management, both from the University of North Texas. Besides the medical field, Gary was employed at Continental Airlines for many years in the area of customer service and is now with American Airlines. He has become a good conversationalist because of this. Gary is not only a capable song leader, but he is also a very soul-conscious and adept witness for Christ. He is not only such out of a burden for the lost, but also through his dealing with the public in keeping with the nature of his occupations. He is 54 years of age, and is married to Trina, and they have two older teenage sons. He is graduating with a **Bachelor’s Degree with a Bible Major and a Pastoral Minor.** This degree is a 144 credit hour course of study in 48 classes. Gary had these words to say, *“At NBBS we see God take men of all ages and backgrounds and transform them from being ordinary men to being extraordinary servant leaders for Christ.”*

We are Underway!

In the fall of 2022, when we were on the verge of closing on the sale of the property, the interest rates across the nation went up to the degree that it forced our buyer to seek out a secondary loan to fulfill the sales price we had agreed upon. It took them several months to do so. We were able to close in August of 2023. For the next year, we began the work of getting our plans finalized and submitted to the city. Now with our grading permit in hand, the water tap having been made, the silt fence put in place, the trees marked that are to remain, we are now preparing for the excavation! Trees that were to be removed have been taken out, and the layout of the entryway, parking lot, and the building is about to be staked out. **It now appears we will be completed with the construction in time for the fall classes one year from now!**
