We are glad to report that the Bethesda Fundamental Baptist Institute of Monterrey is doing great.

Focusing On Our Graduates: Maria Conchis Rodríguez

Her full name is Maria de la Encarnacion (Mary of Incarnation) but she would rather be called Conchis. As her name implies, she was born to a very catholic home, but over the years most of the family has been saved. She says that the most important decision in her life was made on October 10, 2004 when she trusted Christ as her savior. It was the death of her husband's sister that made her see her need of salvation. She had already visited Bethesda because of a neighbor inviting her to church, but she had never seen herself as "dead" until she looked into the coffin of her sister-in-law. When the plan of salvation was explained to her, she not only got saved, but there was a great transformation in her life. She followed the Lord in baptism, and she and her husband got married (they had been living together for 10 years) and she started going to the institute. Because of her testimony, her husband, her parents and most of their children have been



saved. She graduated in August with an 87.4 average, and is a Sunday School teacher and a soul-winner. She said: "I do not feel a special calling, but that of being the best Christian I can be." We thank God for Conchis Rodriguez.

One of the 7 students that are to graduate this year is Ernesto Morales, pictured with his family. He started a work in a new sub-division in Salinas Victoria, in August of 2011 at the end of a special vacation Bible School they had in their home. Twenty people were saved and during their first year 11 were baptized! They are running between 40 and 50 in Sunday School, with many being saved on visitation (last year 189). Please keep this work in your prayers, and the need that they and 3 other works have in registering with the government. It will cost about \$15,000 pesos
