The Breakfast was on the 10<sup>th</sup>, but we traveled to Caracarai on the 9<sup>th</sup> so we wouldn't have to get up at 6 am to make the 2hr. trip and be there at 8:00. We had Breakfast, our meeting and then had a game. We all had a good time of fellowship and then later a lunch with the church people. Just before we left, the church had a cake for Bill's Birthday so we all sang Happy Birthday. Bill found a bike but his legs were too long to ride on it.

Neither of us were feeling well.

The doctor did a test on Bill's eye on February 2nd to see if there was any improvement after the first injection. He said there was some but wants him to come back on March 2<sup>nd</sup> to check how it is doing after the 2<sup>nd</sup> injection has had time to circulate in the eye.
