Dear Praying Friends,

The basis for a missionary to go on furlough is found in the New Testament when Paul and Barnabas returned to Antioch (Acts 14: 27): "And when they were come, and had gathered the church together, they rehearsed all that God had done with them, and how he had opened the door of faith unto the Gentiles."

Three Goals While On Furlough: 1. We want to honor our Lord and be a blessing to you. Pray that God will use us to be a witness of His saving grace and a testimony with our lives and lips.

- 2. We want to raise support for the Institute. We now have 50 students with the prospect of another 20! Over the years, we have had as many as 10 churches supporting the Institute, but now there are only two.
- 3. We want to raise a building project fund which churches in Monterrey could use and repay with no interest so that it would be available for future works. We would like to raise \$100,000 for this fund.

Thanksgiving: We thank those who have responded towards helping us with the debts we have because of Michelle's previous health problems. So far, just under \$2,000 have come in out of the \$6,500.00 we owe. Thank you! Another need provided was a vehicle that we rent for \$250.00 a month (insurance and maintenance included)!
