Our last letter ended in our asking that you pray that God would give us grace in all the crises so we might glorify His name in all we do, and more souls would be saved. Thank the Lord, someone was praying!

We did go through another set of trials in October; Michelle was hospitalized with double pneumonia and RSV! When she got out of the hospital after being there a week, I had the flu and yes, she got it too! In the mix, I tripped in the church parking lot and broke my right arm in tree places! It put a great hinderance on my writing!

Through it all, we were greatly blessed in seeing souls saved in September,

October and November, both here in the Valley and in Mexico!

September was missions month. We had 3 missionaries come in and the last Sunday of Sept. was our Faith Promise Sunday with a total of \$ 37,183 promised for

missions! We currently support 32 missionaries and will be taking on another 3 this year! Last year the church gave \$31,072 to missions! On the last Sunday of September our people set up booths representing Different countries for the international dinner, and we had plenty to eat. **October**: we don't celebrate Halloween; we celebrate my birthday. And, yes, you guessed it, we had food! That month a missionary came by and

November: we celebrated Thanksgiving at Bethesda. We thank God that Michelle's health has improved and that both of us are doing better now. At the end of November, we were able to go to Mexico to participate in the ordination of Jonatan Jacobo, one of our missionaries, going to Panama.

God is still working amongst the Hispanic people on both sides of the border to take the gospel to the uttermost parts of the world!
