Ten days ago one of the men from our first church was murdered. The police said there was not any reason for the gang to capture, torture and kill him. Something similar had happened the week before. Josue was 26, the youngest son of Gregoria, and the father of a young child. His mother, Gregoria, lived with us for two years, was one of the first persons we met when we came to Honduras and was part of the first church we organized.

Leslie, our oldest son, preached a wonderful message at the funeral home and a young lady came forward for salvation. Lena led her to the Lord. She will be attending our first church as she grows in the Lord. There were about 500 at the funeral that heard the Gospel presented with hope for the future. I brought a short message at the grave site encouraging the people to look up to the Lord for comfort, that is where Josue is. He was a fine Christian man with splendid witness.

The special services with Phil and Debra Sawilowsky were tremendous. There was good attendance and everyone was challenged. Phil did a great job at our national men's conference as well. Debra's music encouraged us and her lesson to the Ladies brought everyone closer to the Lord.
