Greetings from Honduras. We pray that everyone has had a blessed 2022 so far. We know that there is unrest throughout the world, but let us labour, therefore, to enter into His rest. We thank our fellow laborers for their continued support of our ministry through prayer and financial means.

In January, Honduras had a new president sworn in named Xiomara Castro. Though she is a socialist, we pray that God will give her wisdom beyond understanding. A few weeks after the inauguration, the former president that had just stepped down was arrested. The United States had sent an extradition request for him to stand trial for drug trafficking charges. He is currently pending his extradition trial here in Honduras. Please continue to pray for the political situation here in Honduras.



This year I have had the privilege to preach for three different churches here in Honduras. After spending fifteen months studying the Spanish language formally and now informally, God has allowed me to acquire this language and to teach His word in a foreign tongue. However, since language learning is a lifetime pursuit, we ask that you continue to pray that we can refine our Spanish language skills further.



We have recently heard about a work that we might be able to take over from another Baptist Missionary. That missionary was out of a sister church in Texas, and he recently passed away. The work is located about 40 minutes away from here, near the city of Comayagua. We ask for your prayers about this new potential work.
