Greetings from Spain,

After several summers in Honduras, we were unprepared for the summers here in Spain. It has been quite hot, over 100 degrees on some days. We are thankful that we found a home to rent in May and that we are settled in here. We live in a pueblo (town) of about 6,000 people called Roldán.

We chose to move to Roldán because it is centrally located between some of the areas we will need to travel to. The closest Baptist church is in Murcia, about 30 minutes north of here. That pastor is also planting a new church plant in San Pedro del Pinatar, about 25 minutes southeast of here. We are thankful to have a veteran missionary nearby. For the interim, we are able to fellowship with Christians and have someone to ask for advice, as things are quite different here than from Honduras.

We are focusing our ministry efforts in the city of Cartagena, which is about 20 minutes south of here. Cartagena is a city of well over 200,000 people and was founded around 220 B.C. It is a city full of history from the Carthaginians, Romans, Moors, and Castilian Spanish. We have met many Latin Americans in that town already. We have also been working with several Honduras that live nearby and who are excited about the prospect of a new church plant.

Please pray for us as we begin the work of starting a new church plant in the city of Cartagena, specifically in the neighborhood of San Ginés. This work would be the only Independent Baptist in the city. We are looking forward to what Christ is going to do for this city and in Spain.
