Dear Prayer Partners:

I trust that you had a wonderful Christmas celebrating the birth of our Savior and a blessed New Year. Thank you so very much for your prayers and financial support. It is a privilege to be your missionary in Honduras.

In my previous letters I requested prayers for Honduras and the elections on November 30th. I have not commented on them because I was waiting to see how things turned out. I took thirty days of arguing and accusations of fraud, but finally by the deadline of December 30<sup>th</sup>, the winners were declared, and the Congress was sworn in January 23<sup>rd</sup>, the municipal authorities on the 25, and the new President on the 27<sup>th</sup>. There was less violence than other elections, if none this time. The Conservative Party won the Presidency and the Congress. The Socialist party lost dramatically. The two traditional parties control Congress and are planning to co-govern. We praise the Lord that there was so little violence, and most people agree no fraud. Thank you for your prayers and again we praise the Lord that He is in control.

This last week my Dad and I have helped Missionaries Mark and Brenda Liedtke in a different area of Honduras with a Medical Team of 15 people from Heritage Baptist Church of Haslet, Texas. We praise the Lord that we saw over 900 patients in the Medical and Optical areas. Even greater is that they had almost eighty people come receive Christ as their Savior. The local church will be following up on them.

During Easter week, what we call Holy Week, we will have our annual Youth Camp, March 31 - April 4, Tuesday through Saturday. Please pray for us as we make the plans. There will be devotions and classes in the mornings, games in the afternoons, and services in the evenings followed by a game time. As my friend, NBBS President Dr. Jonathan Stewart once said, we want to isolate, inundate, and insulate them with God's Word. We will be studying the book of Colossians. The camp is very expensive for our poor people here, so we ask for your help to provide 50% of the costs for each teen and counselor. That would be \$80.00. We are praying for 60 people from four churches this year. If you can help with this, please make a check out to IBFI designated for Honduras Youth Camp. Please let me know by email how much you can send. We need to receive the funds by March 25<sup>th</sup> please. Please pray for the two teachers, the three preachers, the counselors, and of course for the young people. We pray to see souls saved and the youth surrender to serve the Lord.
