Tricia's dad, John Bearfield, went home to be with the Lord on July 20, 2021. He was 91. It was not totally unexpected, but his health deteriorated very quickly. The Lord helped us to get there before he went home so my wife could have some time talking to her dad. As members of the family gathered the following morning, he went to Heaven singing with my wife and quoting Scripture. To be sure, it was difficult, but "Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints" (Psalm 116:15). I was privileged to preach the funeral and give a clear presentation of the Gospel. We had to make a return trip to Texas to help clean out his house in preparation to sell it. It was very difficult physically for both of us since it was during a very busy ministry time, and we

Our folks were very sweetly concerned about us and prayed fervently for our recovery. Many of our other preachers and their families were also affected. We had to push back the start date of Ganado Baptist Bible College and postpone the Navajoland Baptist Revival. My wife and I are still dealing with some residual effects of being sick, but each day is a better day. Praise His holy name, our God helped us!
