His father, mother and sister, also are saved and attend the church. His father and mother are active in teaching in Sunday School classes and other activities of the church. His father has led the singing, and his mother has helped start the childrens church. They have been a tremendous help to the church.

Josue began to be friends with his cousins(his mother's sisters children). His cousins had been to many VBS and church services, but we do not know if they ever made professions of faith. So, his cousin and Josue got into trouble and they were sent to prison for 4 years. I(Ted) went to see them in jail, when our son, Joel, was married in June 2008. I had the desire to visit them in prison to encourage and to be a blessing to them and to witness to some of the prisoners. He and his cousin were very grateful for my visit. It showed them that I did not reject them. God and I still loved them even when they were in prison.

We later found out that Josue got right with the Lord and began to serve Him and witness to the other inmates. He played his guitar again and composed and wrote a song. When Josue was released from prison this past year 2010, he is attending Victory Baptist Church(Templo Baustista Victoria) and is using his talents for the Lord and has surrendered to preach. He is also, wanting to go to Bible College. Please pray for this young man that God will use Him for His honor and glory.

God can turn your life around if we are willing to serve Him. God is not through with this young man yet nor is He through with us either. He can still use us if we are willing.
